SUNDAY'S GOSPEL, February 22, 2015 – "Jesus came to Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God, and saying, 'the time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news."– *Mark 1:12-15*

LENT–This Sunday is the first Sunday in Lent. In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus has just been baptized by John the Baptist and is led by the Spirit into the wilderness. In Scripture, the wilderness symbolizes a time to be alone; to fast, to pray, and to listen to God. Jesus stayed in the wilderness for forty days. After that time in the wilderness, Jesus begins his work of preaching about the Kingdom of God. During this Lenten season, what are you being called to do to be closer to God?
